Sentence reading ability:

Ability of reading the sentence
from individual letters

Automatic sentence reading
ability

Ability of phrase-patterned
sentence reading

Helpers: understanding how the word sounds, separating words by syllables

Routines: speech-sound recognition and filtering, letter recognition and connection

Knowledge: thoughts, network of thoughts (concepts), network of concepts (texts)
